DESTROYER TOUR/LUNCH AT NAVAL BASE

Saturday, July 31

Tour the Norfolk Naval Base, the world's largest naval facility. Start on the pier as you take an escorted tour of a Guided Missile Destroyer. Pick up your guide at the Naval Base Visitor Center and continue on a driving tour of Admiral's Row, the Naval Air Station, and the piers. Enjoy lunch at the Officer's Club, featuring lemon-pepper chicken. After lunch, continue back to Norfolk and to the hotel. Note: *Please bring photo identification. This tour may be substituted if clearance on the base is not permitted by the military, and refunds can't be issued.*

VIRGINIA MARINE SCIENCE MUSEUM

Sunday, August 1

Spend the day at the Virginia Marine Science Museum. Upon arrival at the museum enjoy nearly 100 participatory exhibits, including a weather room where you can create waves or start a storm. Hands-on exhibits include a touch tank where you can hold a sea star, see a hermit crab's home, or pet a horseshoe crab. This museum recently tripled in size, adding over 500,000 gallons of aquariums. New exhibits include the Norfolk Canyon Aquarium, featuring sharks and other large ocean dwellers, a 70,000-gallon sea turtle aquarium, a river otter habitat, and an outdoor aviary. Watch the resident decoy carver practice his craft, or walk a boardwalk through a salt marsh. Gather at the theater entrance for the feature IMAX presentation. This spectacular facility wraps you in a hyper sensory experience while you view the multi-story screen. Through special technology, IMAX gives you the feeling of being in the picture, so you can experience every scene, every motion with eye-opening clarity. Visit the lunch Café for a snack or drink before leaving. *Reminder: Check out of hotel before going on tour.*
